On the morning of August 23rd it became official—the ownership of the Point Pinos Lighthouse was transferred from the U.S. Coast Guard to the City of Pacific Grove. Guest of Honor was Congressman Sam Farr, who in 1999 sponsored legislation that allowed the Coast Guard to transfer the Lighthouse property to the City of Pacific Grove. Quoting Farr during the ceremonies, "The Coast Guard will continue to operate the lighthouse according to procedures and contracts with the city, but for all intents and purposes, this is your building."

The lighthouse is currently the responsibility of the Museum Department, run by Director Paul Finnegan.
