This fog horn operated at Point Pinos from the early 1960s to 1993. Compressed air vibrated a diaphragm to produce a single tone. The fog signal characteristic was: 2 seconds blast - 2 seconds silence - 2 seconds blast - 24 seconds silence (a 30 second characteristic). (Courtesy U.S. Coast Guard)
